



Hundreds flock for exhibition opening

ABOUT 600 artists, collectors, supporters and art lovers from regional WA, Perth and the eastern states turned out at the Bunbury Regional Art Galleries on Saturday night for the opening of Closet Circus.

The exhibition has seen about 100 works from the private collection of Bunbury residents Lloyd and Elizabeth Horn go on display.

The Horn's collection has been lauded as one of the most important in West Australian contemporary art and it is expected to be the only time it will be on public display.
